Accommodation centre for young workers – it is a non-profit organization with the aim of :

- Supporting young people, especially with fewer opportunities, to gain access to social and professional autonomy (16-29 years old)

Main topics for the organization:

- Access to housing with a large offer: collective housing, access to individual housing
- Education to citizenship and international solidarity with a specific work on mobility (project called "platform for youth mobility and solidarity") since 2001 (international solidarity projects in Senegal, Ukraine...)
- Training centre since 2016

There are 8 people in the team: 2 youth workers, 1 educator, 1 in charge of financial subsidies for young people, 1 accountant, 1 night watchman, 1 cleaner, 1 director. The team has already hosted a Czech volunteer in 2018.

Mission of the volunteer:

- To support and encourage intercultural learning, European citizenship and develop international mobility projects for young people.
- To participate in the organization and development of the activities organized by the two youth workers, including his/her added-value as "foreigner" (cultural openness, new activities...).
- To participate in organizing workshops and campaigns to raise the awareness of young people on international solidarity
- To help with the organization of international projects and help with leading activities during international youth camps (project in Ukraine)
- To participate in educational activities in the field of human rights, inclusion, citizenship
- To participate in activities that encourage active citizenship (social council of the association)

Many activities will be organized by the host organization to support the inclusion of the volunteer in the project (language support, mentoring, team meeting...). The mentor will also work with the young volunteer on his/her personal project to help with social and professional inclusion of the volunteer at the end of the mission.

An accommodation will be provided to the volunteer within the host organization (individual room).

Profile of the volunteer: there are no specific qualifications required but a motivation to work with other young people, coming from various backgrounds, sometimes from difficult situations. Ability to communicate in English (or French), with a motivation to learn French. Social skills such as communication, open-mindedness and creativity will be appreciated.

3 main topics for the organization:

- Support the access to autonomy for young people
- Encourage active citizenship through collective life
- Develop socialization through activities that maximizes the potentials of the residents (knowledge, attitudes, skills)

There are 14 people working in the organization.

The mission of the volunteer:

Together with the youth workers, the volunteer will participate in the activities dedicated to "international citizenship":

- leading activities in schools and organisations in charge of the inclusion of young people to raise awareness about international mobility
- leading activities within the accommodation center to raise awareness of the residents on citizenship and active participation in society (these activities will be organized mainly on Tuesday and Thursday, early evening)
- supporting international projects for young people : helping with the organization of individual or collective mobility projects
- supporting the team of youth workers in organizing cultural activities for the residents (occasionally, these activities may happen during the week-end)

The volunteer will be hosted in an individual flat (20m2), neighboring the flat of foreign language assistants present in the accommodation centre.

Profile of the volunteer: there are no specific qualifications required but a motivation to work with other young people, coming from various backgrounds, sometimes from difficult situations. Ability to communicate in English (or French), with a motivation to learn French. Social skills such as communication, open-mindedness and creativity will be appreciated.
